We continue to receive complaints of noise that occurs between our building quiet hours of 11pm and 8am each and every day! Be a considerate neighbour!

#### Air Conditioners...

#### **UPDATE #7; UNDERGROUND GARAGE RECONSTRUCTION – PHASE 1**

- ✓ Due to the nature of the renovation and fluctuating cold temperatures, Phase 1 has taken longer than the initial forecast of four weeks.
- ✓ Work in Section 1 was completed on Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup>. All tenants displaced from Section 1 should have already returned to their underground spaces. Reminder: if your space is near the fencing, please back into the parking space to ensure you have no problems exiting, as there is limited space.
- ✓ Work began in Section 2 on Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup>. Vehicle owners of underground stall #'s 15 to 22, 47 to 54 and 66 to 74 have moved out of assigned underground stalls.
- ✓ Temporarily displaced vehicles may park only in the visitors' parking area and along the east side of Hedonics Road. As a courtesy, give our elderly tenants and those who need assistance an opportunity to park in the visitors' area first!
- ✓ REMEMBER NOT TO PARK IN THE CUL-DE-SAC, THE FIRE ROUTE AT THE FRONT ENTRANCE OF THE BUILDING, ON THE WEST SIDE OF HEDONICS ROAD, OR ON MIDDLETON DRIVE!!! Anyone parked in these areas could be ticketed by the City of Peterborough Parking Enforcement team! 'Emergency No Parking' signs have been positioned along the west side of Hedonics Road. For tenants who recently received a parking ticket, please contact me directly at 705-876-1717 ext. 201. I will forward infraction numbers to the City of Peterborough parking department supervisor for his review!
- ✓ Please inform all visitors as well as healthcare and delivery service providers to Valley High 2 to park on the east side only of Hedonics Road.
- ✓ As soon as new information is provided, updates in the form of 'yellow' notices will be placed immediately on bulletin boards and in the elevator lobby on each floor throughout the building. Please read these notices in their entirety.

## Requests for maintenance repairs...

These forms are always available outside the Valley High 2 office door. Your name, unit number, date, description of work required and your signature need to be filled in. Submit these forms in person during office hours or place them in the mail slot when the office is closed. Our maintenance staff are available to tackle issues at the building Monday through Friday between the hours of 9am to 4pm!

## After hour's emergencies...

#### 1. EMERGENCIES - After Regular Business Hours:

- Includes weekends, statutory holidays and Monday through Friday before 8:30am and after 4:30pm.
- Should you have an emergency after hours, please call 705-876-1717 and press '5'.

#### 2. CONTAINER RECYCLING DAY: every TUESDAY and FRIDAY

- Pick up normally occurs between <u>7am</u> and <u>4pm</u>.
- The container recycling bin is located outside at the back entrance of the building. The larger 6 yard bin is strictly for glass and plastic bottles, aluminum cans and milk cartons. For a complete recycling list, visit <u>www.city.peterborough,on.ca</u> and follow the 'Living' tab to Waste Management.

#### 3. GARBAGE and PAPER PRODUCTS RECYCLING DAY: every MONDAY and THURSDAY

- Pick up normally occurs between <u>9am</u> and <u>4pm</u>.
- Garbage should be tightly wrapped in small, strong plastic bags and sealed. Place garbage bags directly into the disposal chute. *Refrain from leaving garbage bags or other items on the garbage chute room floor*.
- The paper products recycling bin is located outside at the back entrance of the building. The smaller 4 yard bin is strictly for paper products.

#### 4. <u>MAINTENANCE</u>:

- If maintenance is required within your unit, please report the deficiency immediately to our office.
- Request for Maintenance Repair forms are always available outside the Valley High 2 office door. Your name, unit number, date, description of work required and your signature need to be filled in. Submit these forms in person during office hours or place them in the mail slot when the Valley High 2 office is closed.
- We will arrange for our maintenance staff or authorized trades people to make the necessary repairs during reasonable hours.

#### 5. <u>PARKING</u>:

- Tenants must register their vehicle in order to obtain a parking space. *Storage of any belongings other than a vehicle in or around the parking space is strictly prohibited*.
- Visitor designated parking is for visitors **only**. Tenants may not park in visitors parking.
- Absolutely no vehicle parking is permitted in the front circle or the loading dock area at the back of the building.
   <u>Note</u>: we are authorized to ticket and tow any unauthorized vehicles, or vehicles not in a designated parking space.

#### 6. <u>RENOVATIONS</u>:

• No renovations are to be done in the unit, unless written permission is given by the Landlord.

#### 7. <u>SERVICE ELEVATOR</u>:

• Expecting a delivery? We recommend booking the service elevator 24 hours in advance. See Diana Gillespie during office hours at the building or contact the main office at 705-876-1717 ext. 201.

#### 8. <u>SMOKE FREE</u>:

• The *Smoke-Free Ontario Act* strictly prohibits smoking in enclosed, common areas such as hallways, stairwells, lobbies, laundry rooms and parking garages of all multi-unit residential buildings.



## April generator testing...

Scheduled testing of the generator will take place twice in April; the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 19<sup>th</sup>. Please keep your doors and windows shut and refrain from using the exits at the southwest end of the building.

#### Laundry Rate Adjustment...

Bear in mind, effective March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017, Coinamatic implemented a rate increase of \$0.25 on all clothes washers at Valley High 2. The '*Normal*' cycle, equivalent to a double load, will increase to \$2.00 per load. The '*Super Cycle*' wash setting, extra wash and rinse time for heavily soiled items, will increase to \$2.25 per load.

Maple French Toast & Bacon Cupcakes
1 cup all-purpose flour
1 cup cake flour

1 – 110g box instant vanilla pudding mix
1 tsp baking powder, 1 tbsp. potato starch
1 tsp cinnamon, 1 tsp nutmeg, ½ tsp salt
1 stick unsalted butter, room temp.

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup packed light brown sugar

1/4 cup granulated sugar

 $1\!\!\!\!/_2$ tsp vanilla extract

4 large egg whites, room temperature

1/4 cup maple syrup

- ½ cup half & half, room temperature
- <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup chopped, cooked bacon (8 strips)

#### Directions:

Preheat the oven to 325F. Place paper liners in a 12- cup muffin tin.
Combine the flours, pudding mix, baking powder, potato starch, cinnamon, nutmeg & salt in a bowl with a whisk.
In a separate bowl, cream the butter and sugars with a mixer on low speed for 6 to 8 minutes. Gradually mix in the vanilla and egg whites until light and fluffy. Add the flour mixture in 3 batches, alternating with maple syrup and half & half, mixing after each addition and ending with flour. Do not overmix. Fold in ½ cup chopped bacon.
Fill each muffin cup ¾ full. Bake until a toothpick inserted in the centre comes out clean, about 40 minutes.

Glaze: Beat one 225-gram pkg. of cream cheese & 2 tbsp. unsalted butter, both at roomtemp. until creamy. Add 2 cups sifted confectioners' sugar, ¼ cup maple syrup &2 tsp cinnamon, beat until combined. Spread on cooled cupcakes.
