Second hand smoke...

Second-hand smoke infiltration in multi-unit housing is an ongoing issue. Under the *Smoke-Free Ontario Act*, that came into effect on May 31, 2006, smoking is prohibited in the common areas of multi-unit dwellings; which include foyers, elevators, stairwells, laundry rooms, corridors and garages.

- Make the first move; deciding to quit is the first step towards better health.

- All tenants are entitled to a clean and safe living environment.
- Smokers, experiment by turning on the kitchen and/or bathroom fans to ventilate your unit.

Air Conditioning units...

If you are operating an air conditioner this season, keep a pail under the unit to collect the excess water removed from the air. Remember to empty the pail daily to prevent overflow onto your balcony and those neighbours below you.
