- ✓ Check weather reports! Environment Canada issues special alerts to notify Canadians of impending severe weather.
- ✓ Winter driving calls for extra care. Cold temperatures, snow and ice may bring about dangerous driving conditions. Slow down, top-up windshield washer fluid and keep the gas tank topped up. See and be seen; clear snow from the hood, roof, windows and lights. Store appropriate safety and emergency winter equipment in your car.
