

Sugar Cookie Truffles

Total Time: 30 minutes

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 15 Baked Sugar Cookies
- 8 oz softened room temperature cream cheese
- 2 tsp Coconut Oil & 1 tsp Vanilla Extract
- Pinch of Salt
- 1 ¼ cup White Chocolate Chips
- Sprinkles for garnish

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Place cookies in a large resealable plastic bag and use a spoon to crush cookies into crumbs. Combine crushed cookies, cream cheese, vanilla, & salt. Form cookie mixture into small balls and place on the cooking sheet and place baking sheet in freezer for 10 minutes. Mix coconut oil with white chocolate chips. Microwave on low in 30 second intervals, stirring in between, until white chocolate is completely melted.



When the balls are chilled, dip in the chocolate and place back on cooking sheet. Decorate immediately with sprinkles. When truffles are dipped & decorated, return to freezer for 10 more minutes to set. **ENJOY!**
