Maple Syrup lover....this recipe is for you!

- ✓ 1¼ lbs. Brussel Sprouts, remove tough ends and halve
- ✓ 4 slices bacon cut into 1" pieces
- ✓ ¼ cup beer (preferably a dark ale)
- ✓ 2 Tbsp grainy mustard
- ✓ 2 Tbsp maple syrup
- ✓ ½ tsp salt
- ✓ 1 Tbsp bacon fat or unsalted butter
- ✓ ½ cup Panko breadcrumbs

Preheat oven to 425F. In a small bowl, combine beer, mustard, maple syrup and salt. On a large cast iron pan or high-sided skillet over medium heat, cook bacon until crisp, about 5 minutes. Transfer to a plate. In the same pan over medium heat, sear sprouts cut side-down until golden brown, about 5 minutes. Stir in prepared beer mixture and bacon. Transfer pan to the oven and roast for about 10 minutes. Meanwhile, melt bacon fat in a skillet over medium heat. Stir in Panko crumbs and toast until golden brown, about 2 minutes. Transfer sprouts to a serving platter and sprinkle with toasted Panko.
