#### Quick & Easy 15-minute Chicken Pasta...

Ingredients

2 chicken breasts cut in strips

1/2 bell pepper cut in strips

2 cloves of garlic diced

1 cup marinara sauce

1/2 cup mozzarella or Italian blend cheese

Parmesan cheese optional

3 cups cooked pasta 1.5 cups dry pasta

1 tablespoon olive oil

- 1. In a medium sauce pan bring 2 cups of water to boil, pour 1.5 cups of uncooked pasta and 1 tsp salt into the water. Cover and allow to cook for 10 minutes.
- 2. While the pasta is cooking, cut chicken breasts and bell peppers into strips. Heat pan and pour 1 tablespoon olive oil into pan, and add chicken, garlic, and sliced bell pepper, saute for 5 minutes.
- 3. After 5 minutes add the marinara sauce and allow to simmer for 5 minutes while pan is covered. Mix well, add the cheese and turn off. The cheese will melt from the heat of the pan.
- 4. Top with Parmesan and ENJOY!!!!
