Apartment living & pets...No matter where you live, it is essential that all pet owners act responsibly. It has been observed; many pet owners are not picking up their dog's waste immediately afterwards. Please be respectful; pick up and always dispose of pet waste in the waste containers at the east, west and back entrances of the building. If someone is being observed not picking up after their dog, please report it in writing to the office. Cat litter must be double bagged and placed directly in the garbage room, not in the outdoor pet waste containers!

Deliveries... When arranging deliveries to the building, please ensure you advise the courier company to bring all deliveries to the back entrance of Valley High II, which fronts on Parkhill Road where the parking lot is located. Failure to do so, may lead to parcels being left unattended at the front entrance door as the front enterphone is out of order. The Landlord is not responsible for any lost and/or damaged belongings left unattended.

Fluctuating Cold Weather Conditions..

Our winter weather has been quite unpredictable so far. Prepare for the cold weather by paying attention to the local weather report. Frozen water pipes are a serious threat during extremely cold weather conditions. Avoid opening windows under exceptionally cold conditions and never turn the heat off completely in your unit. To help prevent freezing and/or bursting pipes, throughout the winter months it is recommended tenants turn up the thermostat within their rental unit once daily to allow flow of hot water. To resolve a persistent issue with too much or too little heat, fill out and submit a request for maintenance form immediately. This form allows Myer Cherney Holdings Ltd. staff permission to access your unit to effect repair.


Underground Parking Garage Speed Limit...
