Volunteering... Have you been thinking about volunteering, but not sure where to start? Volunteer Peterborough can help!



Garlic Potatoes Gratin

Ingredients:

3 pounds red potatoes, peeled and sliced 3 tbsp. butter

6 ounces Gouda cheese, shredded, divided 5 cloves garlic, minced

1 ½ cups heavy cream 1 tsp. salt

½ tsp. black pepper



Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C). Lightly grease a 9x13 inch baking dish
- 2. In the prepared dish layer ½ of the potatoes, ½ of the cheese, then the remaining potatoes
- 3. Melt the butter in a small skillet over medium heat. Saute garlic until fragrant and golden brown; pour over potatoes
- 4. Combine cream, salt and pepper; pour evenly over potatoes and sprinkle with remaining cheese.
- 5. Bake in preheated oven for 75 minutes. Serve immediately.
