This problem is more frequent in winter, as cold water holds air longer than warm water. Cloudiness caused by air bubbles does not pose a health concern, but for some people it is unappealing. After a few minutes, these air bubbles disappear from a standing glass, so a good solution to this problem is to keep a jug of tap water in the fridge for drinking.
