Operating a BBQ on your balcony...

Should you choose to use a barbeque on your balcony, Myer Cherney Holdings Limited supports use of the electric variety only! Peterborough Fire Services neither approves nor regulates balcony propane or charcoal barbecuing due to the potential to leak propane or spread fire. Safety is our priority!

Telephone building access systems...

Remember to remind family and visitors to Valley High 2 to enter the call numbers for your unit slowly and to speak directly into the speaker. *To unlock the door, press '9' on your telephone keypad. To refuse entry to the building, simply 'hang up' or press '4'. Please keep in mind; never buzz anyone into the building you don't know!*

Request for maintenance repairs...these forms are always available outside the Valley High 2 office door. Your name, unit number, date, description of work required and your signature need to be filled in. Submit these forms in person during office hours or place them in the mail slot when the office is closed.

Balcony gardens...

Gardening season is in full swing. Ensure saucers are placed under all plant containers. Try self-watering devices such as ceramic water probes or water globes. Watering first thing in the morning is better for your plants. Avoid overwatering. Be considerate of your neighbours below.

Heat Stress...

It can be deadly!! Symptoms include weakness, fatigue and dizziness. Protect yourself:

- ✓ Check the local weather forecast and weather alerts so you know when to take extra care!
- ✓ Stay hydrated. Drink plenty of cool liquids, especially water, before you feel thirsty.
- ✓ Wear light, loose clothing.
- ✓ Reschedule or plan outdoor activities during cooler parts of the day.
- ✓ Always use sunscreen and keep your head covered outdoors.

August generator testing... Scheduled testing of the generator will take place on August 10th and 24th. Please keep your doors and windows shut and refrain from using the exits at the southwest end of the building.

In the event of a power outage:

- ◆ Keep your fridge and freezer closed. Some foods can be kept for 24 to 48 hours.
- ◆ Ensure electric stove elements, small appliances and electronics are turned off or unplugged to prevent damage in the event of a power surge when the power is restored.
- ◆ Use flashlights or battery operated lanterns instead of candles.
- ◆ Never use outdoor grills or barbeques indoors.

Stay safe; reduce the risk of fire by following these tips!

For everyone's safety...

They blow onto neighbouring balconies or the ground if left in shallow receptacles or on the patio floor!

Building quiet hours are in effect from 11pm to 8am each and every day! Be mindful of the effect excessive noise has on your neighbours!
