Using Technology during an Emergency...

We have come to rely on technology to keep in touch with our family, friends and work associates. In the event of a major emergency, these tools may be vital in assisting you to keep in touch and stay informed. Following are tips regarding the use of technology in an emergency:

- ✓ Use text messaging, email or social media; these use less bandwidth and may work even when phone service doesn't.
- ✓ Conserve your smartphone's battery by reducing screen brightness, placing your phone in airplane mode or closing apps you are not using.
- ✓ Keep extra batteries or a charger for your mobile device in your emergency kit; consider a solar powered, crank or vehicle phone charger.
- ✓ Keep contacts up to date; it makes it easier to reach important people.
- ✓ If you have a smartphone; save your *safe meeting place* on its mapping location.

Make a plan; it will help you and your families know what to do!!

Air conditioning units...

If you are operating an air conditioner this season; keep a pail under the unit to collect excess water removed from the air. Remember to empty the pail daily to prevent property damage or overflow onto your balcony and those of your neighbours below. *All window-mounted air conditioners must be removed by October 15, 2016.* Fill out a maintenance work request form if you need assistance.

Back to school safety tips for motorists...

- ✓ Be aware of school zone signs and reduce your speed in these zones.
- ✓ Watch for children walking, cycling and coming off school buses. Be patient and wait for them to complete their crossing.
- ✓ **Stop** when directed to do so by a crossing guard. They keep our children safe.
- ✓ **Always stop for a school bus with its upper red lights flashing whether you are travelling in the same direction or the opposite lane!**



Canada Post mail delivery...

In recently speaking with a Canada Post agent; officially, the safest and most secure way to deal with misdelivered mail in your community mailbox is to place it back in the outgoing mail. Put misdelivered mail in the red outgoing mail slot in the Canada Post Parcel locker on the main level beside the elevators or in a Street Letter Box. Please refrain from pinning mail to the bulletin board! Contact a Canada Post agent at 1-866-607-6301 to report an issue with recurring misdelivered mail.
